Student Code of Conduct

Expectations in respect of pupils admitted to the Dance School.

The aim of Frogmore Dance school is to ensure that all students experience dance in a fun, friendly, positive and safe environment. In order to achieve this, please take note of the following guidelines. We would like to stress that these points are of great importance in assuring the wellbeing of all students in the School.

Any student unable or unwilling to profit from the education provided at the school may be asked to withdraw from the school after reasonable notice.

Encourage your child to learn the rules of the school and perform within them.

Punctuality

It is vital that students arrive in good time for their classes and please ensure they have been to the toilet before the session has begun. Always inform the Principal if you are going to be late and apologise when you enter class for being so.

If students are late for class they may miss vital information and will impede the learning of others and place themselves at risk of injury should they miss the warm-up section of the class.

Attendance

Regular attendance is extremely important. If students do not attend on a regular basis, the development of the class and the individual student will be affected. Exam students' attendance will be monitored as they prepare for their examinations and assessments and students who fail to attend classes or any additional lessons may be withdrawn.

While taking classes in our core technique subjects of Modern, Tap and Ballet we advise these genres are not studied with alternative dance schools and ourselves. This is to prevent a cross-over of technique understanding which may be confusing for the student.

Discipline

Students are expected to behave in an orderly, civilised and well-mannered way and to show respect to their teachers when attending Frogmore Dance school. Students should also show respect to other students in the school and their classes. Failure to comply with Frogmore Dance Schools rules and regulations may result in a withdrawal from the Dance School.

Students should not post messages on Facebook, Twitter, YouTube or any other social media platform of a derogative nature in regards to any student, dancing discipline or Frogmore Dance school, its students or teacher. This includes in DM's, text messages and via email. Unacceptable behaviour will not be tolerated from students, parents/guardians or any other family members and could result in students and their families been banned from the premises/events/performances or the school itself. Unacceptable behaviour includes – bullying, swearing, spitting, fighting and derogatory comments towards others.

Whilst at examinations/performances/events/festivals you are all ambassadors and representatives of Frogmore Dance school and we expect all students & parents to behave in a manner that is respectful and appropriate. You are encouraged to fully support your school and the dancers within it.

Uniform

It is extremely important that students come to classes dressed in full Dance School uniform in order to be able to work correctly and safely in class and present a neat and elegant appearance. Students hair should be appropriately tied back and off the face for all classes.
