

TRIAL CLASS FAQ:

Q What should my child wear to their free trial class?

A Trial students are welcome to wear comfy clothing to their trial class, ie, leggings and a t-shirt.
For all classes we advise bare feet to be worn, with the exception of tap trials. For tap dance, hard bottom shoes are great. If your child likes the class and wishes to enrol we will inform you of the uniform requirements.

Q Can I watch the class?

A We don't encourage parents to be in the class as this causes distractions. However exceptions were necessary, for example, if a young child becomes upset.

There are windows in the doors of the rooms where the classes are held so you are welcome to watch through these. We also have a wait/changing room and kitchen facilities with free tea and coffee available.

Q What happens if my child doesn't like class?

A The free trial class is non obligational and if the class is not for them, then they are welcome to try other classes if they wish. If they do not wish to enrol, your details are removed from our database in line with our GDPR policy.

Q My child loved the class, how do we enrol?

A Just let us know and we will email all the info over that you need to know along with billing info. You will be invoiced for the remaining classes in the half term.

Q How does invoicing work?

Once enrolled, we invoice before the end of the current half term, with the invoice payable by the first day of the new half term. We ask for a half terms notice, in writing, to end classes with us.
Class are priced as follows:
Childs 30 Minute Class - £62.40 per 12 Week Term (£5.20 per class)
Childs 35 Minute Class - £64.80 per 12 Week Term (£5.40 per class)
Childs 40/45 Minute Class - £71.40 per 12 Week Term (£5.95 per class)
Childs 50 Minute Class - £75.60 per 12 Week Term (£6.30 per class)
Childs 60 Minute Class - £91.80 per 12 Week Term (£7.65 per class)

Q If we enrol, where can I get the uniform?

A Class uniform can either be purchased from us at the dance hall, or at Dancia International in Crowthorne.

Q What about school holidays?

A We work to a 12 week full term were possible. We follow the Hampshire school holidays.These are published on our website.
